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Post-Operative Instructions for Laparoscopic Surgery

General Instructions:

- 1. Diet: No restrictions. Start with bland food and work your way up to your normal diet
- 2. Activity: No lifting more than 20 lbs. until you follow-up in the office
- 3. It is recommended that you walk a normal amount to prevent blood clots and pneumonia
- 4. **Incision care:** If you have skin glue, it is ok to shower over the incisions the day after surgery. Do not soak in a tub or scrub the incisions. Pat dry after shower
- 5. **Follow-up:** Call (816)254-9292 in the next 2-3 business days to schedule a follow-up appointment at about 10-14 days after the day of surgery

Things to expect:

- 1. Pain should improve slowly day by day. The first 1-2 days will be the worst
- Constipation due to narcotic pills. Take over-the-counter stool softeners and laxatives as needed
- 3. Skin glue will start to flake off in the shower in about 10-14 days
- 4. Bruising may occur around incisions

Call the office for:

- 1. Pain that is increasing day by day
- 2. Fevers greater than 101.3
- 3. Skin/eyes turning yellow
- 4. Heart feels like it is racing
- 5. Worsening fatigue
